3. The scarecrows must be in position by 6pm on Weds 22<sup>nd</sup> August – but preferably earlier as it all adds to the fun– they will be judged on the Friday evening. As usual there are no categories. 1<sup>st</sup> prize is a £100 voucher for Dobbies Garden World, Stirling, 2<sup>nd</sup> Prize is a pass for a family of 4 to Go-Ape in Aberfloyle and there are loads of goody bags from Dobbies Garden World as runners up prizes
4. Fill in the entry form below and pop this sheet into the box in the shop before 6pm on Wednesday the 22<sup>nd</sup> to enter – the entry fee is £1.00 which goes towards the gala and local groups.
5. Once you have entered and your scarecrow is out, stick your sticker on the village map that will be erected by the phone box about a week beforehand.
